SUSTAINABILITY	Sourced from responsibly managed tropical forests; an eco-friendly hardwood option
HANDLING	Store Maximo Hardwood boards off the ground, stacked evenly, and covered with a breathable tarp. Keep tarp edges open to avoid trapped moisture. Avoid direct sun, rain, and moisture exposure.
INSTALLATION	Maximo Hardwood decking installs using hidden fasteners or stainless steel face screws. Pre-drill to avoid splitting, and always use stainless steel hardware to prevent staining or corrosion. Boards should be spaced to allow for airflow and drainage. Refer to the Maximo Installation Guide for complete instructions and best practices.
FINISHING & COATING	Protective finishes may be applied depending on desired aesthetic. Compatible with most oil-based and water-based coatings. For best results, consult your coating supplier.
WEATHER EXPOSURE	Cumaru naturally weathers to a silver-gray patina over time. To retain the original warm brown tone, apply UV-protective oil treatments regularly.
